



African-American History Online

Scope: Provides expansive and in-depth information on the people, events, and topics important to the study of African-American history.

How to Access:

- Click on the word “Chicopee CLIC” on the Chicopee Public Library homepage (www.chicopeepubliclibrary.org)
- Click on the label “History”.
- Click on “African-American History Online”.
- Log on using the CLIC username and password. (Check the “Homework Helper” bookmark, or see the librarian, if you forget the username and password).

How to Search?

You have several options to find and explore the information in African-American History Online.

1. **Simple Search:** There is a search box at the top right of the home page. Enter the word or words you wish to search and click “go”.
Example: astronaut

All search results will be displayed. You may select from the tabs at the top of the page to restrict your search to biographies, Primary Sources, or any of the other options listed.





2. **Browse:** The browse option allows you to choose your type of source before you begin searching. Options include: biographies, events and topics, Primary Sources, Timelines, Images and Videos and Maps and Charts.

3. **Learning Centers:** The Learning Centers are selections of hand-picked entries on people, event and topics, Primary Sources and other resources divided into specific date ranges. The Learning Centers provide a broad, inclusive look into a specific era.

Example: 1861-1867: The Civil War and Reconstruction

An advanced search option is available by clicking on the words “Advanced Search” located under the “Help” button.
