Scope: Containing over 1100 titles, cross searchable with E-Books, this periodical database provides access to a variety of indexed and full-text magazines, newspapers, podcasts, and reference books for information on current events, the arts, science, popular culture, health, people, government, history, sports and more.

How to Access:

- Click on the word “Chicopee CLIC” on the Chicopee Public Library homepage (www.chicopeepubliclibrary.org)
- Click on the label “Reference”.
- Click on “Student Edition”.
- Log on using the CLIC username and password or your library card. (Check the “Homework Helper” bookmark, or see the librarian, if you forget the username and password).

How to Search?

Find: (Keyword Search) Find what you want quickly by entering a search term and clicking “search.” By clicking on “more search options” you can specify full-text, date ranges, and publication title.

Basic Search

Example: “supreme court”

Results are sorted according to what sources they came from: newspapers, magazines, academic journals, books, or multimedia. Click on the tab to limit your results to only that source type.

2. **Subject Guide Search:** This search allows you to browse subdivisions or related searches when you type in your search terms. Options to limit your search (to full-text articles, peer-reviewed articles, documents with images, specific dates or specific journals) are found below the search box.

Example: “fish”



Results are listed for subjects including the word fish, along with **related terms**, **subdivisions** and **see** alternate subjects.

3. **Publication Search:** This search allows you to search specific publications for articles. To see all the available journal titles, click on the words “All Publication Titles” below the search box. If you need help selecting titles, you can search by subject at the bottom of the page. Options to limit your search (to full-text articles, peer-reviewed articles, specific audiences or formats and more) are found below the search box.

4. **Advanced Search:** This search allows you to search multiple search terms using Boolean Search terms (AND, OR, NOT) to refine your search further. Additional limiters such as “full-text” and date restrictions are found below the search boxes.
