



Learn-A-Test

Scope: This database allows you to practice for tests right from your own computer (or any computer with internet access). Test preparation includes:

- AP (Advanced Placement) Tests
- ASVAB
- Civil Service Exams
- College Entrance Exams
- GED Exams
- Graduate Entrance Exams
- Health Careers
- Real Estate Tests
- Teacher Tests (CBEST, PPST-Praxis 1)
- U.S. Citizenship

The database can also provide help with math, reading, and writing skills (Elementary School through College level) if you would like to refresh your skills.

Access: If you have a Chicopee Public Library card, you can access the Learn-a-test database with your library card.

To access this database

- Click once on the word “**Chicopee CLIC**” on the Chicopee Public Library homepage (www.chicopeepubliclibrary.org).
- Click once on the label “**Careers/College**”.
- Click once on “**Learn-a-Test**”.
- Sign on using “**New User**” for your first visit.

The first time you go to this database, you will sign on with the “**New User**” button. Your user name is your library card number.

- If you have a card starting with “28138...” simply use your library card number.
- If you have a card starting with “d270..” you will need to add 4 extra digits of your choice to the end of your card number .
- You make up your own password. Then, click “**continue**” to access the database.

After the first time using the database, you will enter by the button “**Returning User**”. The database will save information from practice tests that you complete. If you do not finish a test, it will save what you have completed and you can return later to finish. You can use as many of the “learn-a-test” tests as you would like.
