



## **eMedia: eBooks, eAudiobooks, eVideos**

### **Digital Media-What's available?**

- eBooks are books specifically formatted to view on your computer or other electronic devices. They are available as Adobe and Mobi eBooks.
- eAudiobooks are audio files that can be listened to on a variety of devices including your computer, MP3 Player (that support DRM-protected Windows Media content) and CDs (format is Windows Media Player).
- eVideos are also available to check out through the digital media catalog.

### **What are the computer requirements?**

You will need:

- your own computer with internet access, and
- a valid library card. Before
- to download software onto your computer.
- Windows Media Player version 9 or higher.

*The eAudiobooks are NOT compatible with iPods or Macintosh Computers, but the eBooks work with Macintosh or Windows.*

You can check out a maximum of 5 items at a time in the digital catalog; books are checked out for two weeks and videos for one week.

### **How can I access the audio and eBooks?**

Go to the Chicopee Public Library homepage ([www.chicopeepubliclibrary.org](http://www.chicopeepubliclibrary.org)) and click on the "Find-It" link on the top, "eMedia".

If you just want to see what is available, try browsing by subject or by format. Otherwise, either the "help" tab or the "software" tab can help you get started in downloading your software.

Go to "My Account" to see what you have checked out and what is on your waiting list. The items will automatically "check in" at the end of their circulation times. You won't see what you have checked out in digital formats on your library card record, just in the digital libraries site.
